The undersigned, being duly sworn upon oath, charges:

COUNT 1.

That on or about August 16, 2003, in Moody County, South Dakota, WILLIAM J. JANKLOW did commit the public offense of **Failure to Stop at Stop Sign**, SDCL 32-29-2.1, in that he did as the driver of a vehicle approaching a stop intersection indicated by a stop sign, fail to come to a full stop at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection; and as to

COUNT 2.

That on or about August 16, 2003, in Moody County, South Dakota, WILLIAM J. JANKLOW did commit the public offense of **Speeding**, SDCL 32-25-9.1, in that he did drive a vehicle on a county road at the speed of at least seventy-one (71) miles per hour, where the legal speed limit is fifty-five (55) miles per hour; and as to

COUNT 3.

That on or about August 16, 2003, in Moody County, South Dakota, WILLIAM J. JANKLOW did commit the public offense of **Reckless Driving**, SDCL 32-24-1, in that he did drive a vehicle upon a highway carelessly and heedlessly in disregard of the rights or safety of others, or without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property; and as to

COUNT 4.

That on or about August 16, 2003, in Moody County, South Dakota, WILLIAM J. JANKLOW did violate SDCL 22-16-20, **Manslaughter in the Second Degree**, by the reckless killing of another human being, Randolph E. Scott, by his act which, under the provisions of SDCL 22-16, is neither murder nor manslaughter in the first degree, nor excusable nor justifiable homicide,

all contrary to statute in such case made and provided against the peace and dignity of the State of South Dakota.

That the Complainant states that this Complaint is based upon investigation by the South Dakota Highway Patrol.
